Long Duration Winter Storm Impacts the Area

Snow began moving into the area between 4:00 and 7:00 PM January 3rd with temperatures in the mid to upper 20s. The snow continued to fall, moderately at times, through 8:00 to 11:00 PM that same evening. After this, precipitation changed to a mix of rain and freezing rain. All locations rose above freezing after 1:00 to 4:00 AM January 4th, changing precipitation to plain rain. However, between 4:00 and 6:00 AM January 4th, temperatures fell back below freezing, creating a period of icing across Northern Essex and Middlesex County. These below freezing temperatures persisted through 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM that same day, before precipitation transitioned to plain rain showers with temperatures rising into the mid to upper 30s.
