Winter Storm Brings Significant Snowfall March 3 – 4

A light snowfall developed between 3:30 PM and 4:30 PM of March 3rd, mixed with a bit of rain and sleet at the onset with temperatures between 35 and 38 degrees. As intensity increased, the light mix gradually went to all snow after 5 PM, which then picked up to moderate entering the evening hours. At the heart of the storm, especially between 6 PM and Midnight, snowfall rates became quite heavy falling up to 1-2" per hour at times, with temperatures right near 32 degrees. Snow continued into the overnight at more variable intensity, before ending as flurries between 2 AM and 4 AM on March 4th.
